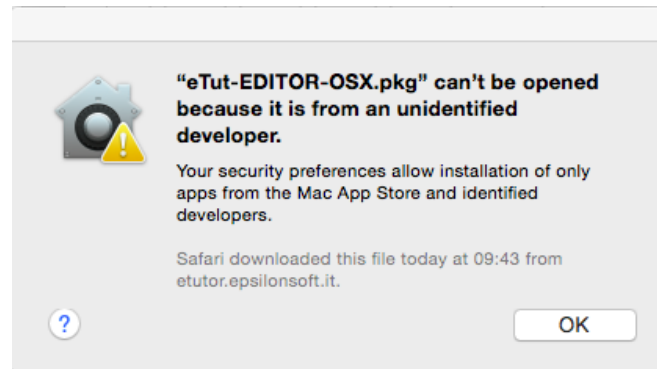
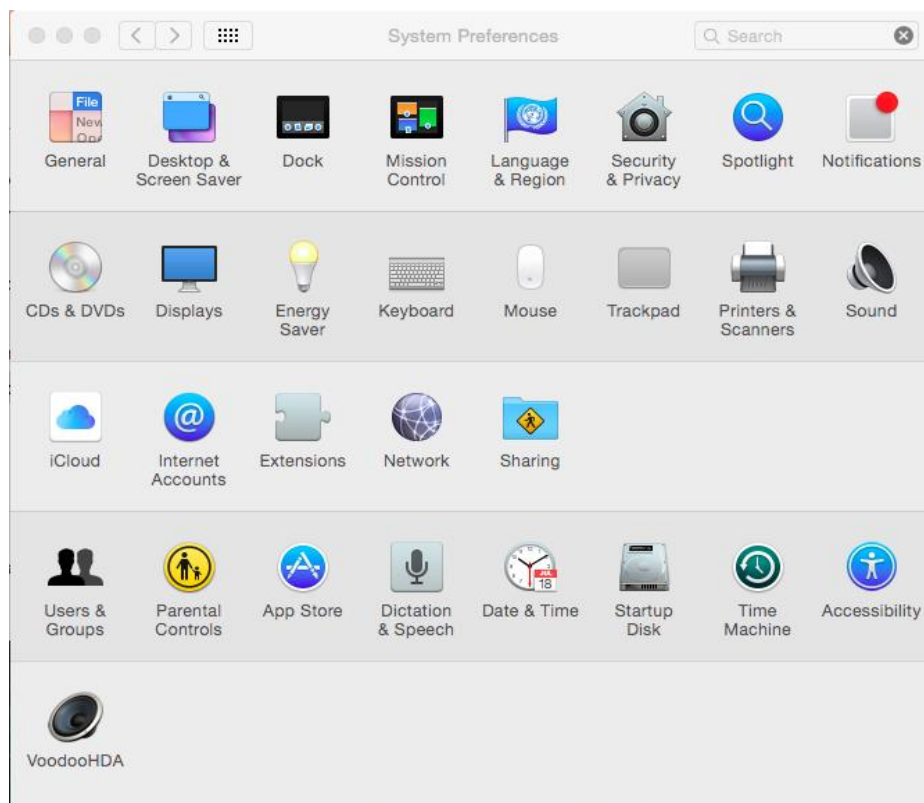


Installation manual for unsigned Apple applications for eTutor EDITOR

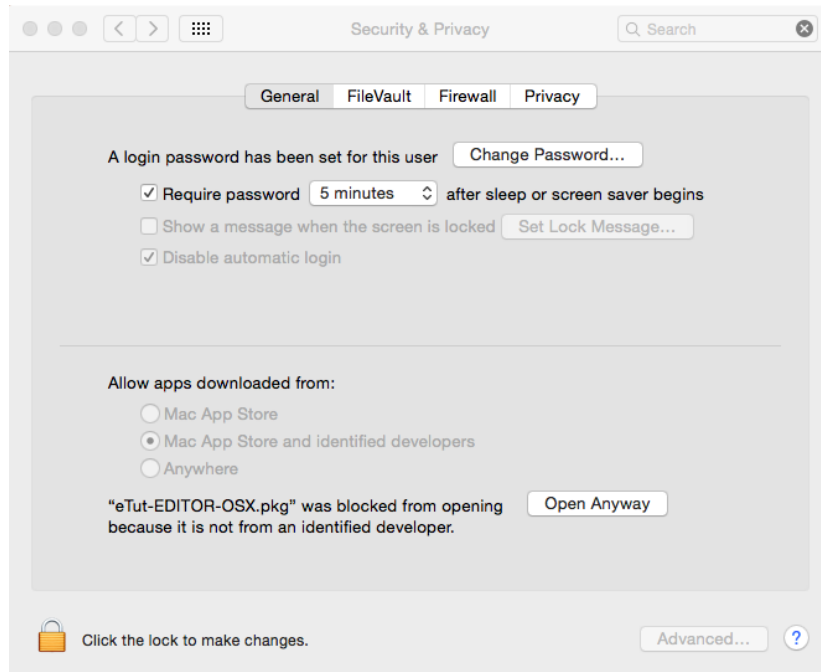
Starting from OS X 10.8 Mountain Lion, Apple has introduced a **security procedure** called **Gatekeeper**, to protect average users from running potentially malicious applications. The following window appears, running the installation package:



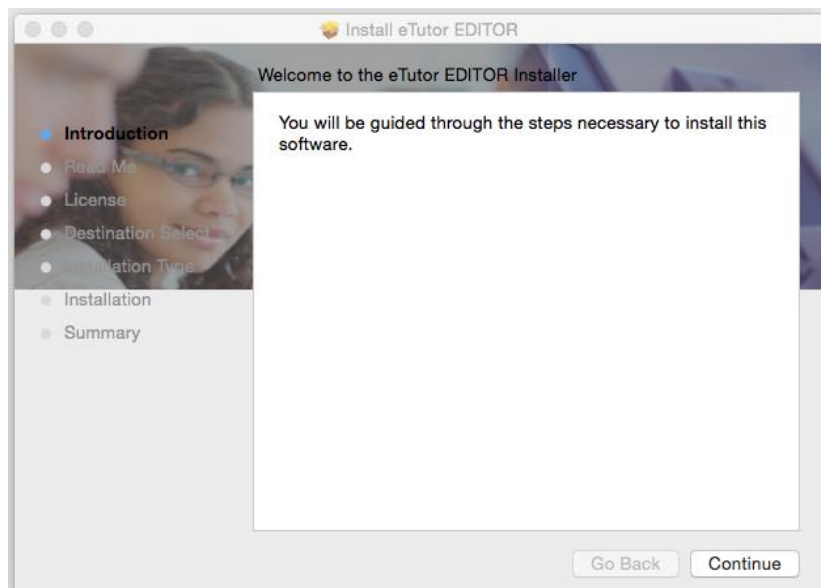
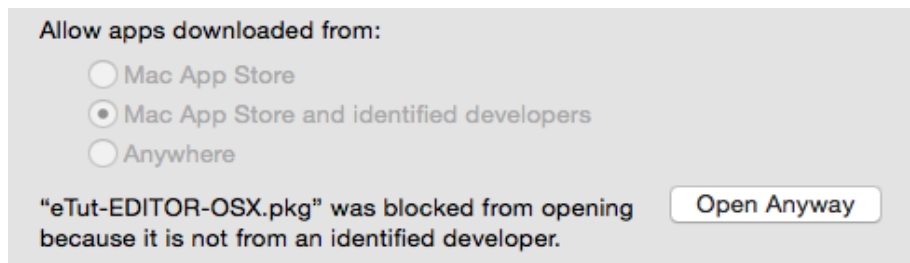
To disable this protection, click the Apple icon at the top-left corner of the screen, and open the: **System Preferences** window



Security & Privacy > General



In the section **Allow apps downloaded from**, click on **Open Anyway**, to disable Gatekeeper and allow the eTutor installation that will start immediately.



To use, in eTutor EDITOR, the formula editor *Formulator*[®], it is necessary to enable the application to control the computer, by checking the following box:
